Dear Friends,

My name is Andrew Wang, a Divine Word missionary (SVD). I was born into a traditional Catholic family in mainland China. I was the eleventh generation of Catholics in my family. My father is always proud to tell us that our family has a martyr whose name is St. Wangrui. I have five


sisters and three brothers. My eldest sister is a nun and my younger brother is also a SVD who is studying Theology in Australia.

I professed my first vows in 2014 in China before coming to the United States and studying the English language and intercultural studies at Divine Word College in lowa. I am currently studying for a Master of Divinity at Catholic Theological Union in Chicago and will graduate in May. With God's grace, I celebrated my diaconate ordination on October 1, 2023, at Our Lady of Africa parish in Chicago, and was conferred by Most Rev. Mark A. Bartosic, Auxiliary Bishop of Chicago.

I am glad to be here with you all as a transitional deacon at St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta Parish for the next two months. I sincerely ask for your prayers and look forward to learning from our Pastor Fr. Francis Li and all of you to prepare myself for the future missionary work. As St. Mother Teresa said, "I am a little pencil in the hand of a writing God, who is sending a love letter to the world." I pray that my service and presence can bring more joy to everyone and experience God's love and peace among you.

Baptisms: Parents must be registered practicing parishioner and attend a baptismal preparation session before a baptism will be scheduled.



The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick at All Masses Next Weekend

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, also known as the Sacrament of Extreme Unction finds its origin in the healing ministry of Jesus. Throughout his life Jesus would seek out the sick and offer them healing. It can take place at the family home, in hospital, in church, or in a communal setting.

The author of the Letter of St. James invites the community: "Are there sick people among you? Let them send for the Priests of the Church and let the Priests pray over them, anointing them with the oil consecrated by Bishop in the name of the Lord". It is necessary for a Priest or a Bishop to administer this Sacrament of Anointing because the forgiveness of sins is among the effects of the Anointing of the Sick.

Any member of the faithful can receive the sacrament as soon as he or she begins to be in danger of death because of sickness or old age. The faithful who receive this sacrament can receive it several times if their illness becomes worse.

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick unites the sick person to the passion of Christ, for his/her own good and that of the Church; strengthens the sick with peace and courage to endure in a Christian manner serious illness; forgives sins, if the sick person was not able to obtain it through the Sacrament of Penance; restores health, if it is conducive to the salvation of one's soul; and prepares the believer to pass over to eternal life. (Catechism of the Catholic Church Numbers 1499, 1500, 1513, 1532)
