# **Carry On the EASTER LIGHT**

As we continue the celebration of Easter season, I am still being enlightened by our Easter Vigil celebration. How powerful and beautiful for us all to bless the new fire and rekindle our baptismal candles from the paschal candle, the light of Christ. Our newly baptized received their lights for the first time and joined us for the renewal of their baptismal vows. Light is not only what we need in life, but also is what we are called to be in the world. Now we must be the light of Christ for others. Pope Francis describes this beautifully as follows:

In the liturgy we relive the state of mind of the disciples over the news which the women had brought: Jesus is Risen! We have seen him! If only we were so luminous! But this is not just cosmetic! It comes from within, from a heart immersed in the source of this joy, like that of Mary Magdalene, who wept over the loss of her Lord and could hardly believe her eyes seeing him risen. Whoever experiences this becomes a witness of the Resurrection, for in a certain sense he himself has risen, she herself has risen. He or she is then capable of carrying a "ray" of light of the Risen One into various situations: to those that are happy, making them more beautiful by preserving them from egoism; to those that are painful, bringing serenity and hope.

Our celebration of the joyful paschal light and resurrection has to be lived out in our dark world and in our everyday lives. May each of us be empowered by the Risen Lord to carry on the light!

**Confessions:** Saturdays, 4:15-4:45 p.m. at St. Barbara Church or by appointment.

**Ministry of Care:** Eucharistic Ministers are available to visit, pray with, and bring Holy Communion to those who are sick and unable to attend Mass.
