Seeing the Face of Jesus

Pope Francis in *Urbi et Orbi* on Christmas 2022 stressed the need for peace in our World today. He reminds us that the celebration of the birth of Jesus can empower us to strive more eagerly for peace.

Brothers and sisters, let us turn our eyes to Bethlehem, and listen to the first faint cries of the Prince of Peace. For truly Jesus is our peace. The peace that the world cannot give, the peace that God the Father has bestowed on humanity by sending his Son into the world. Saint Leo the Great summed up the message of this day in a concise Latin phrase: *Natalis Domini, natalis est pacis*: "the Lord's birth is the birth of peace" (Serm. 26, 5).

Jesus Christ is also the way of peace. By his incarnation, passion, death and resurrection, he has opened the way that leads from a world closed in on itself and oppressed by the dark shadows of enmity and war, to a world that is open and free to live in fraternity and peace. Brothers and sisters, let us follow that road! Yet in order to do so, to be able to walk behind Jesus, we must divest ourselves of the burdens that weigh us down and block our way.

On this New Year's Day, we are called to peace. As we also celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God, we turn to Mary to intercede for peace. Mary can help us to see Jesus in all people, particularly children, refugees, and all sufferers.

Jesus' Self Revelation by Sister Caritas

Today our Gospel continues to tell the Christmas story. We hear the story of the shepherds, the first to find Mary, Joseph and Jesus. They go in haste following the information told them by the angels. They saw the infant Jesus with Mary and Joseph. They are filled with Joy. The shepherds shared this information with others. Everyone who heard the message were amazed.

How surprised Mary and Joseph must have been with the story of the shepherds and the coming of others. "Mary kept these things, reflecting on them in her heart." What must they have thought and wondered. The shepherds went on their way, telling others and "praising and glorifying God." What is our response in reflecting on this wonder filled story and reality? A week later, Jesus is named, "given the name Jesus, the name given him by the angel before he was conceived in the womb."

We also have Jesus revealed to us. The revelation is the feast of Christmas, Jesus' birth. What is our response to this revelation? How deeply are we touched by this revelation? Does it change our lives? Can we allow the revelation of Jesus to us deeply impressed and radically change us? Let it deepen our faith in Jesus. May we allow this revelation of Jesus to be shown through our lives. May it touch others and bring a faith filled transformation to all we meet.


Baptisms: Parents must be registered practicing parishioner and attend a baptismal preparation session before a baptism will be scheduled.
