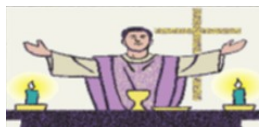

THE MANDARIN'S DREAM

Once upon a time a mandarin in the interior of China heard a missionary preaching on today's Gospel concerning the birth of Jesus, who would be called Emmanuel. After listening intently, the mandarin said to himself, "This Christian religion is certainly a strange religion; who could ever believe this doctrine of 'God with us'? How could that be? Why, our great Chinese religions like Confucianism and Buddhism have no such foolish notions of God becoming man, of being born and living among us, and finally sacrificing himself to save mankind. Who could ever believe such a strange doctrine?"

Then one morning not long after that, the mandarin excitedly ran up to the missionary saying, "Father, last night I had a dream and now I think I understand. I dreamt I fell into a deep pit, where I lay helpless and despairing. Soon a teacher of Confucius came and leaned over the edge but saw that it was hopeless, so he said to me, 'My friend, you should never have let yourself fall into that hole. But when you do get out of that hole, come to me and I will teach you how never to fall into that hole again.' Then he went on his way. Next, a Buddhist monk came along; he stretched his arm over the edge and said, 'Friend, if you can manage to climb up far enough for me to grab your hand, I'll pull you out.' But as I could not climb far enough to reach his hand, he also left. Then Jesus came; he looked, climbed down into the pit, let me stand on his shoulders, and I was able to climb out. Father, I wish to learn more about this Christian religion."

In today's Gospel Matthew quotes the prophecy of Isaiah to show that Jesus, the son of Mary, is indeed Emmanuel, "God with us." With the birth of Jesus, God became present to his people in the flesh and blood of person of Jesus. No other religion except the Catholic religion claims to have God coming to live amongst us 2000 years ago, and continuing to be present on our altars and in our tabernacles, because only we believe in His abiding "Real Presence" in the Eucharist today. So just as we often say, "Every Mass is a little Easter," we can also say, "Every Mass is a little Christmas," since the Mass indeed makes "God with us" until the end of time. That is why both we and the mandarin can rejoice today. Happy Emmanuel Sunday!

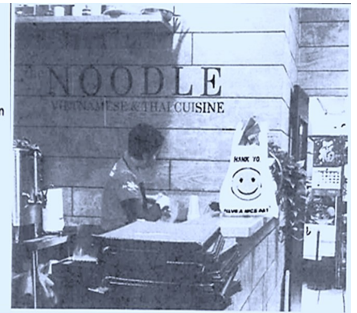
