JESUS CHRIST, SUPERSTAR by Fr. John Cuff

Many have seen the movie Jesus Christ Superstar, or at least heard the music; it certainly is a very inspiring and well-done movie. The title song says, "Jesus Christ, Superstar, who are you, are you who they say you are?" But, unfortunately,



the movie doesn't answer the question but leaves it hanging in mid-air: Was he the Son of God or not? An interesting point about the movie is that it was made not by Christians at all, but by Jews who had originally produced it as a very successful Broadway play The unfortunate thing about the movie is that it totally leaves out Christ's resurrection. It takes us to his death and then leaves him there—hanging on the cross—and that's The End. Thus the movie, in omitting the Resurrection, has missed the whole point of who Jesus was, the whole meaning and triumph of his life and death. But for us Christians, Jesus is not only a Superstar with the rest of us simply adoring fans and spectators, but rather the Savior of the world; and we who are blessed with faith believe that we too will one day rise with him. Indeed, that's the whole point of the Good News, Jesus' victory over death, and the producers of Jesus Christ Superstar missed it, since of course they don't have the Christian faith, and as a result the movie ends sadly, as a tragedy in fact.

The same mistake made by the producers of Jesus Christ Superstar is made today by the two disciples on the way to Emmaus, who almost closed the book before the last chapter. They began walking away before they learned of the resurrection, away from Jerusalem, from the upper room, where the rest of the Christian community had gathered. Thus they almost miss out on the joy of the Good News until of course Jesus catches up with them in the guise of a stranger and reveals himself in the "breaking of the bread." Some Catholics, like these two disciples, make the same mistake. Easter happens but they don't realize its real meaning for their lives. They leave Easter out of their thinking, out of their living. They don't attend Sunday Mass during the year and so they wonder why they become discouraged, disappointed, weak in their faith. They become disillusioned, and so start walking away from the Christian community, away from the Eucharist, away from the very thing that'll help them out of their confusion: they start walking away from the Mass, which unites us with God and is our link with Easter joy; the true reenactment of what happened that first Easter morn. I hope none of us close the book before the last chapter of the Gospel story, as did the producers of Superstar.

Every life is precious in the eyes of the Lord and every person is born for a reason. Though the world would like to believe that some lives are less valuable than others - all lives are worth saving, even to death on the cross.

As an attorney with Asperger's syndrome, I never understood how I fit into the kingdom of God and evangelization, but the "Joy of Gospel" helped me integrate my profession with evangelization of the Gospel.

Last year, a potential client came across my path. He also had Asperger's syndrome and because of that, the other attorneys misinterpreted his intentions and communications. These attorneys did not want to represent him for various reasons and most suggested a guardianship was needed due to his condition. This means someone needs to watch over his finances and make decisions for him. He was struggling to find employment and his mother recently passed away. Sudden changes are difficult for those on the autism spectrum.

When I met him for the initial consultation, I empathized with his struggles and knew that with time, he would overcome sudden life changes just as I had. I took that chance and represented him because he is a child of the Lord Jesus Christ and needed an advocate who understood him; we are not here to judge others, especially when they have not shown us they are incapable. Just as Christ is our advocate before the Father, I am now this person's advocate before the world.

Eventually, he did find employment. The world labels others. Judges them as incapable and disabled, but the Lord God does not. The Lord God loves all children, handicapped, disabled, however born and/or labeled by the world. This is how I evangelize the Light of our Lord Jesus Christ to others.
