World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly

Last year, Pope Francis established World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly throughout the Church on the Fourth Sunday of July, close to the Memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, Parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

So this Sunday we particularly honor all Grandparents and Elderly in our community. We thank God for them and assure them of our affections and prayers. In his message to them and

to the Church, Pope Francis titles it, "*In old age they will still bear fruit* (Psalm 92:15)." The Holy Father wants to remind us all that the elderly are not only bearers of wisdom and love, but they continue to bear fruits with their lives in many different yet significant ways both in our Church and in society. The Pope invites them to see aging as a blessing and to take care of themselves and remain active in their later years. They must also cultivate their interior life through prayers, reading the Word of God and receiving the Sacraments.

On our parts, as families and young generation of people, we must celebrate with them and find ways to show our care for them. In his own words, Pope Francis wrote:

The World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly is an opportunity to proclaim once more, with joy, that the Church wants to celebrate together with all those whom the Lord – in the words of the Bible – has "filled with days". Let us celebrate it together!

I ask you ...to seek out those elderly persons who feel most alone, at home or in residences where they live. Let us make sure that no one feels alone on this day. Expecting a visit can transform those days when we think we have nothing to look forward to; from an initial encounter, a new friendship can emerge. Visiting the elderly who live alone is a work of mercy in our time!

Let us ask Our Lady, Mother of Tender Love, to make all of us artisans of the *revolution of tenderness*, so that together we can set the world free from the spectre of loneliness and the demon of war.


