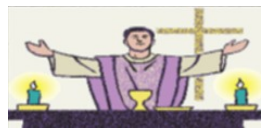

FAMILY PRAYER

A story for Holy Family Sunday: A young man in Scot-
land hired himself out as a worker to a wealthy farmer;
he liked the work and seemed to be doing a good job,
but after two weeks he quit and returned home. A friend
asked him, "Why did you quit your job? Was the work
too hard?" "Not at all," replied the young man. "Was it
the wages?" "No," answered the youth, "the pay was
excellent." "Well, then why did you quit?" "I'll tell you,"
he replied, "There was no roof on the house." In Scot-
land, "no roof on the house" is an expression used to
indicate a home where there's no family prayer.

When hearing the terms "Family Prayer" and "Holy
Family," I recall how back in the day, our grade school
nuns encouraged us to say the Family Rosary after
supper, asking families to kneel down before the TV
came on and say the Rosary, and several did so. I sus-
pect the Holy Family themselves might have practiced
something similar in their home in Nazareth, meditating
on any scriptures they may have had on hand. Certain-
ly, with the prophecy of Simeon at Jesus' Presentation
in the Temple still fresh in their minds, Mary and Joseph
would have had much to ponder on regarding what had
been foretold to them by Simeon about what lay before
them.

Again, concerning this subject of Family Prayer,
here's another story on family prayer that is certainly
relevant for Holy Family Sunday: A pastor was doing a
parish census and one of the questions was, "Do you
have any kind of family prayer in your home?" One fam-
ily, the Wongs, replied, "Truthfully, Father, we just don't
seem to have the time." So the priest asked them,
"Supposing you knew that one of your children would
become sick if you did not pray together, would you
have some kind of family prayer then?" "Oh, I guess we
would," answered Mr. Wong. "And suppose you knew
that on the day you failed to do family prayer, one of
your children would be injured in an accident, would you
pray then?" This time both Mr. and Mrs. Wong an-
swered, "We most certainly would." The priest went on,
"And supposing that each day you failed to pray togeth-
er, the law would fine you twenty dollars, would you ne-
glect family prayer then?" Mr. Wong replied, "I'm sure
we would pray, Father, but why are you asking all these
questions?" "Just this," said the priest, "Your problem is
not time; you could find the time; the problem is that you
don't believe family prayer is important, as important as
paying a fine or keeping your family healthy. You love
your children, but you don't see that God's blessing that
you receive through family prayer is more important
than anything else, am I right?" Mr. and Mrs. Wong both
had to agree. End of story.

Please contact parish office for any of the following:

Baptisms: Parents must be registered practicing parishioners and attend a baptismal preparation session before a baptism will be scheduled.

Communion Calls: Please contact the Rectory when someone who is homebound or in the hospital wishes a visit to receive Holy Communion or the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. The Anointing of the Sick is for anyone seriously sick and not only for those near death.

Confessions: Saturdays, 4:15-4:45 p.m. at St. Barbara Church or by appointment.

Ministry of Care: Eucharistic Ministers are available to visit, pray with, and bring Holy Communion to those who are sick and unable to attend Mass.

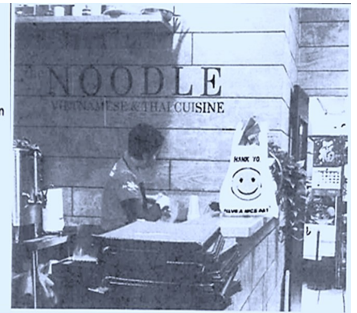

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Before all else, I want to express a word of gratitude to you. Thank you for the many ways that you contribute to the mission of the Archdiocese and support the many efforts of this local Church. On a personal level, I am grateful to you for your collaboration. It is an important source of encouragement for me. In this holy season, I will bring you, your loved ones, and my gratitude to the Lord in prayer.

Our Christmas celebrations coincide with the beginning of winter. There is less light at this time of year and more cold than we might want. The contrast is striking for people of faith. We remember God's only begotten Son born of the Virgin Mary. He comes into a dark and cold world as its light and its warmth.

Whatever struggles we face, we are assured because he walks with us.

As you gather with family and friends and fellow parishioners, I urge you to reassure each other with our convictions of faith. Take responsibility in the world and in our Church to be a sign of hope and a source of encouragement for others. In this way, you will bring Christ the light to those who need him.

Join me and pray for our Archdiocese, our world, our nation, and our local communities that we can all walk in the light.
