On Evangelization by Parishioner Roberta Cheong

Right before Jesus ascends to Heaven, He leaves us with a mission to make disciples of all nations. And on Pentecost, He sends us His Holy Spirit so that we have the power to go forth and carry out His mission for us.

The Responsorial Psalm on Pentecost at Mass was Psalm 104:30 "Send forth your spirit, they are created and you renew the face of the earth." The way I interpret this psalm is that God fills us with the Holy Spirit and then acts through us in the world to renew the Earth. We are in a team with the Holy Spirit to renew the Earth... by bringing people to follow Jesus.

We enjoyed pizza together while sitting with Sister Caritas

and other parishioners. I introduced Steve to everyone around us. Steve shared with our fellow parishioners his testimony of how he decided to return to the Catholic Church after being away for a long time. Everyone was blessed by Steve's presence and sharings.

At the end of the Alpha session, I silently prayed in my heart that Fr. Cuffe would exchange phone numbers with Steve, because I think that Steve could learn a lot directly from Fr. Cuffe. God answered my prayer again! Immediately after I prayed this, Fr. Cuffe asked for Steve's phone number.

What I learned that day is that many times I look outward and await God's answer to my prayers through other people, but sometimes God sends us to answer our own prayers. We are the answer to our prayers.

God used me to invite my friend Steve to Alpha and I was his only friend at St. Therese, so God used my friendship with Steve to make him feel welcomed to join us. I was chosen and sent for that moment, because no one else knew him here. Thus, Steve was the new person to Alpha that I had asked God for that very morning!

Who is God asking YOU to invite? Maybe that newcomer in the back of the church is waiting for YOU to invite them to be part of our parish and to join our activities. Maybe someone has been wanting to return to church and God is sending YOU to invite them back to Mass. You are chosen by God and He sends YOU to go forth and make disciples.
