WISE AND FOOLISH VIRGINS

Imagine ten bridesmaids getting ready to go and await the arrival of the bridegroom. Their conversation goes like this: "Do you think we ought to take some extra oil?" "Why? The program says the bridegroom will be arriving at sunset, doesn't it?" "Yes, but what if he's delayed? We won't have enough oil for the night!" "Come on! Why be so negative? You always complicate matters. You want us to take extra oil that we're not going to use? Why can't you look on the bright side of things?" "Well, yes, but you never know. Me, I'm taking along some extra oil, just in case..." We know the rest of the story. The bridegroom is delayed and the bridesmaids who took extra oil prove to be the wise ones. Wisdom here has little to do with personal intelligence or IQ. Wisdom is a choice---a choice to do what it takes to prepare for the worst while hoping for the best. The foolish virgins only hope for the best and don't prepare for the worst.

Perhaps some understanding about Jewish weddings in Christ's time may help to understand the story better: On the wedding day the bridegroom and his friends would go to fetch the bride from her family. Since the ceremony took place at night, the bridegroom's party would usually arrive sometime after sunset at the bride's home, where the bride and her bridesmaids awaited them. Upon the groom's arrival, the bridesmaids would light their lamps to escort the bride to the groom's family where the ceremony would take place. They would carry lighted lamps for the night journey and sing love songs as they went. However, in the parable, the groom is delayed and arrives at midnight, when the five bridesmaids who hadn't prepared discover that they're out of oil, and need to go to the village to buy some. Then, by the time the bridesmaids return, the procession has already left for the bridegroom's house and they find themselves locked out. They must have got the shock of their lives when they called out, "Lord, lord, open to us!" and heard the voice of the bridegroom say, "Go away, I do not know you."

This parable, found only in Matthew's Gospel, served as a warning to early Christians who expected a speedy return of the Savior. Matthew is telling them that the Lord may be delayed, and therefore to prepare for the long wait by having enough oil in their lamps. The bridegroom is Christ. The bride is the Church. The ten bridesmaids are the members of the Church. Their lamps represent faith which all Christians have. The oil, which some had and others not, represent good works. A lamp without oil is like faith without good works---dead and useless (James 2:17). Thus, the way to prepare for the end is not to live in fear and anxiety; rather, by following the example of the wise virgins who took enough oil to keep their lamps burning. In the same way we should engage and persevere in good works to keep our faith alive and ourselves ready to meet the Lord, no matter when He chooses to come, so that we'll not find ourselves locked out of the festivities.




