The 10–15-minute survey can be accessed through an online link from **February 18 to March 29, 2026** and will ask you to reflect on your own spiritual growth and enable you to provide your perspective on our parish's efforts to help you grow in relationship with Christ. All responses will be confidential, and the parish will only receive information about the community as a whole. We will share the link with you a bit closer to the launch of the survey. Paper surveys will also be available for those who do not have the ability to complete the survey online.

Together we must embrace Christ's vision for missionary discipleship so our parish can thrive and be a place for others to grow together in faith.

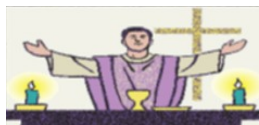

2026 Annual Catholic Appeal Announcement Weekend



Next week is Commitment Sunday for the 2026 Annual Catholic Appeal in our parish. This year's theme is **Together We Bring Light**. In its own way, it continues last year's focus on hope both in the context of the Holy Year and last year's Appeal. By saying that we bring hope together, the theme continues our reflection on synodality, walking on the road together. It is also very opportune to reflect on the unique light that is given to us and which we carry forward into the world.

So often we can feel that darkness is enveloping the whole world. Think of wars and civil unrest around the globe. Think of the plight of refugees and migrants. Think of different forms of insecurity that many people face every day, insecurity about food, medical care, housing, and personal safety. Think about structures that foster discrimination, a lack of fairness, economic exploitation, disrespect for human life, and the degradation of the earth's resources. In countless ways, it seems that darkness tightens its grip on us and on our world. In this context, this year's theme, Together we bring light, is not only timely but urgent.

The light that we bring is Jesus Christ. The Annual Catholic Appeal is a pathway to bring light. Through the Appeal, we support parishes in need, Catholic schools, programs of religious education, and Archdiocesan initiatives for respect for life, for making peace, for



preventing violence, and for training leaders in our faith communities. The Appeal also supports Catholic Relief Services and brings light to victims of war and natural disasters.

Our parish's target for the 2026 Appeal is \$24,283. As you know, when contributions exceed the goal. Our parish will receive a rebate from those donated funds.

Due to our Lunar New Year celebration on Sunday Feb. 15th, we had to move up ACA one week ahead of the proposed schedule by the Archdiocese. So, our ACA schedule is as follows:

ACA Announcement Weekend: Jan. 31st-Feb. 1st
ACA Commitment Weekend: Feb. 7th-8th
ACA Follow-Up Weekend: Feb. 14th-15th

There are envelopes and brochures available for you at the entrance of church for you to take on your way out. Across the next week, I invite you to reflect, pray, and ask yourself how you can help to bring the light of Christ to the world. As we consider God's many gifts to us, we should also reflect our gratitude by using and sharing those gifts. Your financial support for the work of our parish, our archdiocese, and the Church throughout the world is one way to express that gratitude. Please pray for the success of this year's Appeal and consider to make a commitment next weekend when we will hear a pre-recorded message from our Cardinal and go through the in-pew pledge process.

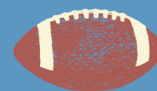

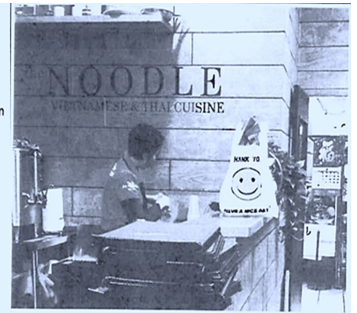
