## St. Barbara HVAC PROJECT - UPDATE:

As everyone can see, the St. Barbara Church HVAC system has been completed and is running. The total cost of the project was \$329,781 and includes additional costs paid to Peoples Gas and for the fence/barrier. As of today, we have collected \$59,000 from our generous donors in the parish campaign. With a \$100,000 from "To Teach Who Christ Is" (TTWCI) and \$100,000 in matching donations we are \$50,000 short from the original goal, plus another \$20,000 to full project costs. Please remember that to finish the project we got a loan from the Archdiocese. The loan balance to be paid as of today is \$34,443.
