LORD, INCREASE OUR FAITH by Fr. John Cuff

A man falls off a mountain cliff; half-way down he grabs a branch of a tree. There he dangles, unable to pull himself up, knowing that if he lets go of the branch he'll definitely fall to his death. Suddenly he gets an idea. He looks up to heaven and shouts, "Hallo, up there! Is anyone up there?" A voice comes from heaven, "Yes, I the Lord am here." The man says, "Oh, thank goodness! It's you, Lord! Lord, I'm down here dangling from a branch; please help me!" The Lord says, "Do you believe in me?" The man shouts back, "Yes, Lord, I believe in you with all my heart. Please help me!" The Lord says, "All right. If you really believe in me you've nothing to worry about. I'll save you. Now let go of the branch and trust me." The man thinks about it for a moment and then shouts back, "Hallo! Is anyone else up there?"

Is the man in the story a believer? Of course he is. He believes that God exists. He believes that God can save him from his predicament. And, yes, he prays to God. But if he truly believes in God as he claims he does, then why doesn't he take God at His word and let go of the branch? Is not God able to save him? Many of us laugh at the story because we can recognize ourselves in this man. We believe in God, but when the going gets tough and things don't work out as we'd hoped, we begin to look for help elsewhere. We believe, yes; but like the apostles we're people of little faith. They too believe in Jesus and follow him; but seeing the soldiers approaching to arrest Jesus, they abandon Him and flee. The difference between us and them is that whereas we often see ourselves as having and keeping the faith, they know their faith is weak, so they come to Jesus and plead, "Lord, increase our faith!" In doing so, they show they are wise. As the saying goes, he who does not know, and does not know that he does not know, is a wise man.

Many of us Christians assume that since we're baptized, we've sufficient faith to be saved; but the apostles realize that their faith is lacking and so take steps to improve their faith by asking for help. What steps have we taken in the past year to develop our faith? How many retreats, alphas, or Bible studies have we attended? How many religious books or articles have we read? These are means by which the Lord increases our faith. The mistake of the young man is that he lacked faith in God's unfailing love for him and His power to save him. Indeed, God's unconditional love for us demands only one response, unconditional love and service of God, such as Mother Teresa exemplified. So many of us Christians today think that true and mature faith consists in our ability to obtain miracles from God. But often the saints such as Mother Teresa, at times felt nothing from God, yet they continued to believe and trust.

Your pastor, Fr. Li, will soon be participating in the Catholic Leadership 360 Review process. This review process is part of the ordinary structure required by Archdiocesan Policy of every diocesan priest approximately every five years. It is an opportunity for Fr. Li to recognize his talents and to grow to become a better priest and pastoral minister. Selected members of the parish staff and parish leadership, your Dean, and myself will be asked to be reviewers using this instrument.

According to Archdiocesan policies lay leadership and parishioners are to be given the opportunity to recognize Fr. Li gifts and to share their sentiments about his ministry. So, we are providing a parish-wide survey as part of his review process. The survey can be easily accessed by going to the Archdiocese's web page (https://www.archchicago.org/) and clicking on Offices and Ministries on the top panel. This will bring you to an alphabetical listing of offices. Under 'M', select Ministerial Resources for Parishes. You will then be directed to the Ministerial Resources for Parishes webpage. In the middle of the page, you will find "Parish-wide survey review for priests". The survey is available in English, Spanish, and Polish. Please click on the word 'Link' next to your appropriate language to access the survey.

If you have any concerns or comments pertaining to Father's review, feel free to contact me directly. If you have any further questions or suggestions about the review process you may contact Fr. When the Catholic Leadership 360 Review process has been completed Fr. Li will be asked to share the insights he has received and his further developmental plans with you in the parish bulletin and on the parish web site.

ST. BARBARA CHURCH'S HVAC PROJECT






Baptisms: Parents must be registered practicing parishioner and attend a baptismal preparation session before a baptism will be scheduled.


