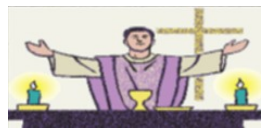

EASTER

As we solemnly and joyfully celebrate the paschal mystery of Jesus' death and resurrection, we are reminded all the deaths we experience in our lives and our profound desire for resurrection. Below are excerpts from Pope Francis' last year's Easter message before he returned to our heavenly father.

From the empty tomb in Jerusalem, we hear unexpected good news: Jesus, who was crucified, "is not here, he has risen" (Lk 24:5). Jesus is not in the tomb, he is alive!

Love has triumphed over hatred, light over darkness and truth over falsehood. Forgiveness has triumphed over revenge. Evil has not disappeared from history; it will remain until the end, but it no longer has the upper hand; it no longer has power over those who accept the grace of this day.

The resurrection of Jesus is indeed the basis of our hope. For in the light of this event, hope is no longer an illusion. Thanks to Christ — crucified and risen from the dead — hope does not disappoint! Spes non confundit! (cf. Rom 5:5). That hope is not an evasion, but a challenge; it does not delude, but empowers us.

All those who put their hope in God place their feeble hands in his strong and mighty hand; they let themselves be raised up and set out on a journey. Together with the risen Jesus, they become pilgrims of hope, witnesses of the victory of love and of the disarmed power of Life.

Christ is risen! These words capture the whole meaning of our existence, for we were not made for death but for life. Easter is the celebration of life! God created us for life and wants the human family to rise again! In his eyes, every life is precious! The life of a child in the mother's womb, as well as the lives of the elderly and the sick, who in more and more countries are looked upon as people to be discarded.

What a great thirst for death, for killing, we witness each day in the many conflicts raging in different parts of our world! How much violence we see, often even within families, directed at women and children! How much contempt is stirred up at times towards the vulnerable, the marginalized, and migrants!

On this day, I would like all of us to hope anew and to revive our trust in others, including those who are different than ourselves, or who come from distant lands, bringing unfamiliar customs, ways of life and ideas! For all of us are children of God! I would like us to renew our hope that peace is possible!

In the Lord's Paschal Mystery, death and life contended in a stupendous struggle, but the Lord now lives forever (cf. Easter Sequence). He fills us with the certainty that we too are called to share in the life that knows no end, when the clash of arms and the rumble of death will be heard no more. Let us entrust ourselves to him, for he alone can make all things new (cf. Rev. 21:5)!

I pray and hope Pope Francis' words and wisdom can help us renew our faith, hope and need for peace this Easter. May the risen Lord bless you and your loved ones with abundant joy and love. May your Easter be filled with God's choicest blessings. Happy Easter!

OUR EASTER DEBT OF GRATITUDE

There's a humorous anecdote about an old pastor who finished up his Easter homily by announcing, "Brothers and sisters in Christ, since I'll probably not be seeing many of you till next Easter, may I now take this opportunity to wish all of you a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year!" A similar story tells of a man who criticized his pastor saying, "I've been coming to this church for three years now and each time the homily is on the same topic! Doesn't Father have anything new to preach about?" Yes, the man had been coming to Mass for three years alright; but he only came on Easter Sunday, and so he only heard a homily on Jesus' Resurrection! Yes, both funny stories for Eastertime. But on a more serious note, they raise a rather disturbing question: Why do otherwise good Catholics miss coming to Mass every Sunday, as the Third Commandment commands?

The Paschal Mystery of Jesus' Passion, Death, and Resurrection that we complete today recorded His last words on the Cross: "**It is finished,**" which is translated from the Greek word "**tetelestai.**" What does the word "**tetelestai**" refer to? A few years ago archaeologists in the Holy Land excavated a tax collector's office which was discovered almost intact, including all its tax records. There were two stacks of tax records; one stack had the word "**tetelestai**" on top of it, which translates "**paid in full.**" These people no longer owed anything! And so, when Jesus on the Cross said, "It is finished," what did He mean? What is finished? It's the debt we owe God by our sins that's been paid in full. Jesus often spoke of sin as debt and forgiveness as a cancellation of debt. He told the parable of the unforgiving servant in terms of debt and taught us to pray, "**Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.**" He clearly used the language of commerce to describe our spiritual relationship with God and with our neighbor. So, when on the cross He says "**tetelestai,**" "paid in full," mankind's sins are totally forgiven. Our debt is cancelled.

Today on Easter Sunday, how do we respond? What do we have to do? All we need to do is to believe Jesus' words apply to us personally, no matter how great our sins. Our debt has been paid in full and cancelled, no matter how huge the amount. Indeed, all we need to do is to say "Thank you, Jesus" and show our gratitude by our lives. That's why we go to church every Sunday, to offer the Eucharist, which means "thanksgiving," and that's why we avoid sin. If Jesus has paid all the debt we owed to God, we must ensure that we don't accumulate more debt by the sin of missing Mass. Let's make every Sunday an Easter Sunday!

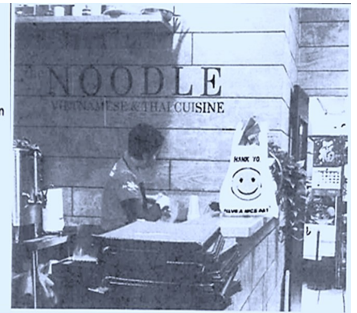
