Li to recognize his talents and to grow to become a better priest and pastoral minister. Selected members of the parish staff and parish leadership, your Dean, and myself will be asked to be reviewers using this instrument.

According to Archdiocesan policies lay leadership and parishioners are to be given the opportunity to recognize Fr. Li gifts and to share their sentiments about his ministry. So, we are providing a parish-wide survey as part of his review process. ### Heart-to-Heart With God: Part 1 by Roberta Cheong

8 years ago, I was hospitalized and diagnosed with kidney disease. Deep down, I genuinely wondered if I was about to die soon. After I returned home, I was praying to God one morning and I asked Him plainly, "When am I going to die?" Immediately, I heard a very clear and definite voice from the Holy Spirit in my soul that replied, "60." I didn't know then that this knowledge would become a great gift to me from God.

8 years later, I now understand why it was crucial that God and I had that talk. God knew the kind of extraordinary suffering that was in stored for me, and He wanted me to be totally confident that I would not die no matter what I go through until I'm 60. That conversation with God made me completely fearless and unafraid during those 30+ times I was hospitalized and the 27+ surgeries I've had over the past 8 years. I think the only reason I survived all that and am still alive today is because God wants me to be alive for His purposes, so He's sustaining me. No matter how sick I was, for every medical emergency and operation I had, I knew with absolute certainty that I would be fine. God gave me that peace of mind and reassurance right from the beginning of my illness, and this has given me the boldness to face anything and the ability to think clearly and make my own medical decisions based on whether it was God's will, thorough research, and logic, rather than based on fear or blindly trusting my doctors. Like when I was diagnosed with end-stage renal disease 5 years ago, I analyzed the results of my blood tests, researched it, prayed about it, considered how my life would change, and spoke to other patients with ESRD, and then I consciously made the decision to start dialysis. Through the knowledge God gave me in advance, I was gifted with an unshakeable joy and a lightheartedness, even during the times when I nearly died, like that time I stopped breathing for 10 minutes and my lips turned blue while I was having dialysis.

That one-on-one moment with God was so intimate that I never told anyone about it until 6 years later. At the end of 2018, I entered into a coma and my body turned dangerously cold. During that time, my parents cried a lot and kept calling my name in the hopes of waking me up. My doctors asked my parents multiple times to leave work in order to have meetings with them so that my parents could make end of-life decisions on my behalf. No one knew when I would wake up or if I was ever going to wake up. My parents had never before been so scared and worried that they might

lose their daughter. When I woke up 5 days later, it was already 2019. After my parents told me what had happened, I felt terrible that I had caused them so much anguish. I have the best parents in the world, and it's clear the reason why God blessed me with them to be my parents—because God knew the heavy cross I would have to carry in life. So He gave me incredible and selfless parents who gave me unconditional love and undying support—parents who drove over an hour after work every day to visit me every time I was in the hospital.

One morning a year later, I woke up in tears with a sudden intense fear of losing my parents and a profound love for them—a love more profound than I had ever felt for them. I believe that God was giving me a supernatural grace to feel exactly how my parents felt when I was in my coma. Instantly, I wanted my parents to have the same confidence and peace in their hearts that I had—the knowledge that I'm not going to die no matter what happens to me until I'm 60. I wanted them to go and live their life instead of worrying about losing me. So I told them about the conversation I had with God. By now, my parents and I are used to me constantly ending up in the ER and being hospitalized, and they are not alarmed by it anymore. Riding in ambulances and living in a hospital for weeks and months at a time has become a normal part of my life.

It's possible that God might change His mind and decide to give me a longer or shorter life, but honestly, I've long arrived at the point where I'm prepared to die at anytime. I'm more focused on fulfilling God's purpose for my life rather than the length of it. I've offered up and surrendered everything to the will of God, and I have no attachment to the world, no attachment to any sin, and no attachment to my own plans. I'm happy whether I'm on Earth or in Heaven.

### ST. BARBARA CHURCH'S HVAC PROJECT


