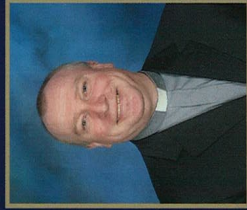

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Sometimes, in order to experience God's love we must endure many difficulties and trials.

Sometimes He allows us to be tempted to sin in order to test our love for and faithfulness to Him.

Why does God allow us to experience many difficulties and trials?

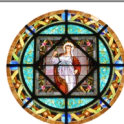

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is a program for anyone inquiring and seeking information about entering the Catholic faith.
