




ST. MOTHER TERESA OF CALCUTTA

There have been questions regarding the name of our newly formed parish. With the release of the official Decree from the Archdiocese this past week, which is included in this weekend's bulletin and website, I am able to address questions we all had. I invite you to take some time to read the most recent decree and the original decree. Together, they thoroughly clarify the following questions. I am also going to be establishing channels in the coming weeks for questions you might have that can be addressed via appropriate formats. New information will be shared as Renew My Church continues to unfold.

- 1. What is the official name of the unified Parish?** The answer is St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta. It is my understanding that we will be the only Parish in the Archdiocese to have this name, and we are very blessed to have this highly coveted name of a modern-day Saint, most of us are old enough to remember.
- 2. Why did we get a name that was not on our list of suggested names?** It is the Cardinal's divine privilege to decide. In good faith, I truly believe that St. Mother Teresa chooses our unique community to be named after her. She wants to watch over us and protect us and intercede for us. Our community has already received blessings through St. Mother Teresa and the Missionary Sisters of Charity. There will be many more to come.
- 3. What do we call the two churches of the new parish?** St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta Parish consists of St. Barbara Catholic Church and St. Therese Chinese Catholic Church. Both churches are open and retain their names in perpetuity.

Using the Renew My Church language, these two churches are known as two Worship Sites. The word church has many meanings. It can mean the physical building, in which case it literally means worship site. It can also mean “the called out ones,” the people of God, the kingdom of God, the temple of God, the bride of Christ, and the body of Christ.

4. **How is the School related to our parish?** St. Therese Chinese Catholic School is a parish school of St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta Parish. It has two campuses: St. Barbara Campus and St. Therese Campus.

It will take time for us to get used to our new name, as special and beautiful as it is. It is very important to know that the physical buildings of these two historic churches will always be known as St. Barbara and St. Therese Chinese Catholic Church (formerly Santa Maria Incoronata). Together we as missionary disciples are called to **Renew My Church** as St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta Parish.

Finally, today's readings speak about stewardship. I thank you for all the ways you have supported our parish. Moving forward, we continue to rely on your participation and generosity to “**build up the new reality**” in our parish.

TWO MASTERS by Sister Caritas

Many times in our everyday life, we are faced with choices between two very opposite views. Sometimes they are choices between two good things. Sometimes they are choices between one good thing and one not as good. Other times it seems we only have choices between bad situations or persons.

In today's Gospel we have the story of a steward who is about to lose his position. He will be without income or honor. He tries to figure out what to do. In the story, he decides to make friends with his master's debtors by lessening their debt but by cheating, perhaps, his master. He thinks these debtors will hire him when he loses his position. He seems to choose himself and his future rather than the welfare of his master. In reality, the debtors see what he is doing to his master. While they are profiting by the steward's decisions, they see what kind of person he is. Would they want such a person working for them?

Jesus ends the story with some pointed statements. “No servant can serve two masters. He will either hate the one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and mammon.” Jesus is calling us to be single-hearted. We cannot serve the world, or power, or pleasure when the pull of these things calls us away from God and His will. Sometimes following God even makes it hard to do what others whom we love want. What are you seeking in life? What do you want more than anything? That is what is important to you. Do you choose God or do you choose other things? God is THE Master to follow and to choose.


