The Call to Build the New Reality

This past Tuesday I attended a day of workshop titled: "Cultivating Community, Communion, Communion in Our Parishes." Over twenty pastors who are in the process of Renew My Church (RMC) attended this spiritual day. Fr. John Kartje, rector of Mundelein Seminary, offered a powerful talk on "Life at Boundaries." He uses the images of the Gardens of Eden and Gethsemane to illustrate his idea that how resistance can be attractive as well as transformative. Resistance can be transformative if we are open to turn to God in times of disruptions and crisis. We all experience this in one way or another way during the RMC journey. As we transition from Operations phase into Build the New Reality, it is essential for us to focus our attention on Jesus. Our personal relationship with Jesus is indispensible for our community to become stronger and attractive for others to join in. The old saying says so well, we can't give what we don't have. Peter beautifully captures this truth in the Acts of the Apostles when asked to help by a crippled man at the "beautiful gate" by stating, "I have neither silver nor gold, but what I do have I give to you: in the name of Jesus Christ the Nazorean, rise and walk."

Do we have Jesus in us? Are we willing to share this Good News with others?

Next Tuesday members of our parish staff will attend another day of workshop on "Leading in a Renewed Church." Please keep them and all people involved in Renew My Church in your prayers.

Dedication and Mission by Sister Caritas

Once in a while, we meet people who are dedicated to a ministry or goal in their lives. Each day and in every way, they strive to obtain the goal they feel called to. Saints are people like that.

In our readings today we hear of such a call and in the Gospel we have an example of such a person. John the Baptist witnesses to the call he received and what he was told to look for. He knows he is to prepare the way for "the one who is to come." He recognizes that that person is greater than himself. John has been given a sign to look for since he does not know whom it is. "The one upon whom the Spirit comes and remains, He is the one who will have baptized with the Holy Spirit." John sees the Spirit come upon Jesus in the form of a dove and he knows Jesus is the one. John recognized Jesus and fulfills his mission by telling others that Jesus is the one and that they should prepare to receive Jesus and His teaching. John's life in the desert was a preparation for the fulfilling of the call he received. He spends time preparing people by his preaching and identifying Jesus as the one when he recognizes Him. "He is the one who will have baptized with water and the Holy Spirit." John's whole life focused on the coming of Jesus. He was completely dedicated to this.

We received a mission, a call, when we were baptized. Like John the Baptist, we are called to make Jesus known. We are called to show people what Jesus was like by our actions. How do you reveal Jesus to others? Do you think of that as your call? Do your actions conform to the words you say about God? Would outsiders "know we are Christians by our love?" That is our call today. Each of us has a special gift given to us to do this ministry. Do you recognize your gift? More importantly, are you focused and dedicated to using your gift to reveal Jesus? Pray for the Spirit to help you to be dedicated and to recognize the Spirit acting in your life.
