We Are Called and We Are Sent

Today's readings remind us that "one's life does not consist of possessions;" and we have no control over our death. They urge us to store up treasures in heaven. Cardinal George in his last days on earth wisely said, "**The only thing we take with us when we die is what we have given away.**" What we want to take with us is what we need to work on now. We are not talking about material possessions, but spiritual matters.

In the last two weeks, our unified parish staff members have reflected on and shared the gifts that God has given to each of them and our common gift of the Eucharist that God has left for all of us. We all are gifted. How we use our gift is our response to God's generosity, compassion and promise of salvation to us.

In *Co-workers in the Vineyard*, the United States Conference of the Catholic Bishops remind all Catholics of our call as stated in the Second Vatican Council "that all Christians in whatever state or walk of life are called to the fullness of Christian life and to the perfection of charity, and this holiness is conducive to a more human way of living even in society here on earth."

This call is also lived out in the ways that we participate in the life of our Church and of our parish. For example, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, readers, cantors and choir members, catechists, pastoral council members, visitors to the sick and needy, those who serve in programs such as sacramental preparation, youth ministry, ministry to people with disabilities, and charity and justice.

Just Today by Sr. Caritas

Every day we get up and begin our day and have many plans. We save our hard earned money for the future, for our retirement. We work very hard to provide for our families and to have what our families need. Some young people, when asked what they want to do with their lives say, "I want to be rich."

Our readings today talk about living our life now. We are reminded we should not be surprised if we have sorrows, grief and worry. All these everyday worries are "vanity. All is vanity." In our second reading, St. Paul reminds us that we should be "dead" to our old selves. He writes telling the early Christians to "stop lying to each other, give up impurity, evil passions" and other ways of our ordinary life. We have "put on Christ. We are a new creation." There is no more "Greek or Jew, slave or free, "St. Barbara or St. Therese." We are all one in Christ Jesus. Jesus tells us in His parable story that we should not seek to pile up material goods and riches and worry about the future. His story reminds us we never know when, where, or how we will die. When we die where will all our treasures and riches go?

Many spiritual writes and teachers speak of living in the present moment. In reality we do not have the past. All that is left are memories, if we can remember. We do not yet have the future. It is not given to us yet. All we have is the present moment and the next moment and the next hour, or day, or what God gives us in our lives. What we are called to do is keep Jesus's law of love. We are called to remember God is with us in this present moment. We are asked to do the best we can at this moment, not looking over our shoulder at the past or running thoughtlessly forward toward the future with no concern for the "matters of God." Today, this part of the day, is given to us. Embrace each moment, offering God the love of our mind, and heart, strength and will. Today is the gift God gives us. Walk in Jesus' footprints. He shows us the way. Give each part of the day to God, knowing He walks with us, walks beside us, often holds us in His arms on the way.
