One of the ways is **radical hospitality**. We must find more effective ways to become a welcoming community. In many ways, we are hospitable people and community. Radical hospitality calls us to do more as a faith community. A few leaders and I attended a workshop on this particular topic recently and I have been inviting people to be part of this important ministry. So if you are called to be hospitality ministers, please do not hesitate to speak with me.

Another possible tool is Alpha. Many of you might be wondering what is Alpha?

Alpha is a tool to introduce people to an initial proclamation of the good news of Jesus Christ—the Kerygma. Alpha often starts with food and fellowship, but leads to a question asked by many people—young and old alike, "Is there more to life than this?" Alpha works on the premise that faith itself blossoms only by hearing the Kerygma. Alpha offers a welcoming small group experience of a meal, short movie and facilitated discussion. It is a unique place of the "first encounter," which then allows parishes to lead people deeper into discipleship and the next steps of faith enrichment, formation, sacramental initiation, and service. <u>https://www.renewmychurch.org/parish-grouping-process/building-the-new-reality</u>

#### **RELIGION IN CHINA TODAY** Back to the Center of State and Society

For almost a century, Chinese leaders have pursued an agenda of top-down secularization, with most religions heavily persecuted or banned.
