## From the Desk of Fr. Francis

#### Greetings of Christ's Peace and Joy! Hope you all had a blessed week.

#### **Thanks and Congratulations**

Thanks to all students who came to clean St. Therese Church on Sat. Nov. 2<sup>nd</sup> and to members of Young Adults who fixed the restroom walls and painted the rectory stairways last Sunday.

Thanks to our musicians for representing our parish at the Unity Concert last Sunday at St. Gabriel Church and special thanks to our choir directors, Lily May and Eva Mrgan, for their leadership.

Congratulations to St. Therese's girls' volleyball team. They played last Saturday at De La Salle and earned 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the silver championship!







#### At the Resurrection

As we quickly approach the end of this liturgical year, the readings remind us of the coming age. They invite us to ponder about the reality of death and our hope for heaven and resurrection. Our Church also urges us to especially pray for all the faithful departed in this month through our personal prayers and through our communal celebrations, particularly through offering masses for our loved ones.

It is with this awareness that Cardinal Cupich issued new Funeral guidelines for all Catholics in the Archdiocese, titled, "When the Time Comes." If you haven't heard or read about it, I would like to call your attention to this pastoral letter. Below are a few highlights:

- Evening Vigils These should be scheduled the night before the Funeral Mass and the burial, but variations by exception are possible.
- Eulogies, stories, and favorite songs are most appropriately shared during this time of visitation at the Evening Vigil.
- The Funeral Mass Celebrating Mass with the body present has been the norm in our Catholic tradition. On such occasions Christians join as a community of faith in the work of redemption taking place as the Risen Lord receives the deceased. At the funeral Mass we recall that just as we become one with Christ through our Baptism into his death, so now we pray that the deceased will be one with Christ in his Resurrection.
- Eulogies and Personal Remembrances, as noted above, are more appropriate during the Evening Vigil or at the reception following the funeral. Experience shows that sharing personal remarks at the Funeral Mass can be inopportune for a number of reasons. It can create hard feelings if hurtful things of the past are raised or create discomfort in ill-advised attempts at humor. There are also concerns in view of past experiences that eulogies can overshadow in length and attention the Funeral Mass itself, especially if those offering words turn the Church's rites into a celebration



of life that focuses only on the accomplishments of the deceased's past, with scant attention to our faith in the resurrection. With that said, in a desire to be pastorally sensitive to the family of the deceased, the following norms have been established after consultation with the Presbyteral Council and the approval of the cardinal.

The pastor of the parish may allow a reflection by one individual. This is to take place between the Post-Communion prayer and the end of Mass. The personal reflections should be limited to 3 minutes and are to be presented in writing to the pastoral minister assisting the family in advance of the service.

#### **Respect Life Corner**

Could This Louisiana Case Lead to an Overturn of Roe vs. Wade? The U.S. Supreme Court is back in session, and has determined it will hear arguments in a case from Louisiana that could be a bellwether of how the Court will determine abortion cases moving forward.

The case, June Medical Services v. Gee, involves a Louisiana law that requires any doctor performing an abortion to have admitting privileges at a hospital nearby. The law is similar to a Texas law that was struck down (Whole Woman's Health vs. Hellerstedt) by the Supreme Court three years ago. To discuss the case, Steven Aden, Chief Legal Officer at Americans United for Life, shared his insight on Relevant Radio®.

Aden explained what exactly the court will consider in hearing arguments for this case, saying, "The Supreme Court will decide this term whether the Louisiana law is the same, different enough from the Texas law, or whether it should overturn the Hellerstedt decision and go a different way. Or even, conceivably, if the Supreme Court is ready, willing, and able to overturn Roe vs. Wade and return the question of abortion to the states."

"The other half is the cross petition filed by the State of Louisiana against the abortion provider," he continued. "And that one was also granted, so the Supreme Court will decide the questions presented by Louisiana also, which is: Why do we assume that abortionists like June Medical can stand in the shoes of their patients and challenge the constitutionality of the very health and safety laws that are designed to protect patients from them?"

Some may wonder why it would be necessary for an abortion provider to have admitting privileges at a nearby hospital when the abortions will not be performed at that location. Aden pointed out that it is a matter of protecting women and children in the event of an emergency.

He said, "Statistics that even the abortion industry agrees with say that 0.3%, and it might be as high as 1%, of abortions end up in the hospital. So if you've got somewhere between 1 in 100 or 1 in 300 abortions ending up in a hospital in any given year, and you have thousands of abortions being done in that state in any given year, then obviously you've got dozens of women being transported to the hospital every year for abortion complications."

"I think it's reasonable and I think it's common sense that the state requires that abortionists cannot abandon their patients anymore. Right? They say, 'Hey, if something goes wrong, just go to the ER. They'll fix it up for you.' That's what they do now, and it's not acceptable."

Speaking on the future of abortion laws in America, Aden expressed optimism that the current justices serving on the Supreme Court will rule differently than justices have in the past.


